Main Facilities



1 Nakajima Lock

This lock regulates a 2.5-meter difference in water level. When a boat enters the lock chamber, the gates close behind and in front of it, with the water level gradually changing like a water elevator. You can experience this fascinating process aboard the Fugan Suijo Line.

2 Fugan Canal

5.1-kilometer-long canal built for cargo-carrying boats that connects to the sea. Even after the decline of water transport, it remains a valuable waterscape within the city. The former boat basin has been transformed into Kansui Park, a serene spot where people can relax and unwind.

3 Outside Amphitheater

This stage is situated on the waterfront and surrounded by grass. Set against the backdrop of a small canal, this venue is suitable for ceremonies, performances, concerts, plays, and other events (rental available upon reservation). When not in use for events, it serves as a space for visitors to relax and take a break.



4 Wild Bird Observation Hut

Located in a corner of the park, the Wild Bird Observation Hut is an ideal spot for quietly observing the creatures that gather along the canal. From inside, where a wide field of view is ensured, visitors can leisurely watch wild birds throughout the seasons.



5 Ushijima Lock

A wooden lock located between the Fugan Canal and the Itachi River. It regulates a water level difference of approximately 60 centimeters by opening and closing sluice gates mounted below the surface of the lock doors. It is a registered tangible cultural property of Japan.



6 Fugan Suijo Line / Boarding Area

Enjoy a scenic cruise along the nature-rich Fugan Canal aboard a sightseeing boat. Routes include passage through the Nakajima Lock and onward to the port town of Iwase. The service operates from April to November.

7 Tenmon Bridge

A symbolic landmark of the park, Tenmon Bridge features observation towers equipped with elevators at both ends (open daily from 9:00 a.m. to 9:30 p.m.). From the towers, visitors can enjoy panoramic views of Kansui Park, and on clear days, they can even catch a glimpse of the Tateyama Mountain Range. The bridge is also beautifully illuminated each evening from sunset until 10:00 p.m.



8 Fountain and Waterfall Plaza

This plaza features a cascading water curtain that flows like a waterfall every 20 minutes, along with a reflecting pool designed to evoke the image of a natural spring. Like Tenmon Bridge, the area is illuminated from sunset until 10:00 p.m., with a special light display shown for five minutes at the start of each hour as well as 20 and 40 minutes past the hour (not available during winter).



9 Museum of Art and Design Promenade

A riverside path along the Itachi River connecting the park to the Toyama Prefectural Museum of Art and Design. Lined with cherry trees said to be a thousand years old and featuring sculptures of the museum's mascot, Miruzo, the promenade is also an enjoyable walking route. Occasional events and performances are also held here.
